## **Famous Dates in Ukrainian History**

- 700 BC Scythians develop warfare on horseback
- 482 Kyiv is founded
- 840 First mention of Ukrainian empire
- 856 Askold becomes king of Rus, ruling from Kyiv
- 863 Saints Kyril and Methodiy create the Cyrillic alphabet
- 882 King Oleh takes control of Kyiv
- 907 King Oleh defeats the Byzantines
- 988 Ukrainian empire accepts Christianity as its official religion
- 1027 Saint Sophia Cathedral in Kyiv is constructed
- 1111 Ukrainian empire defeats the Pechenegs
- 1228 King Danylo re-unifies Kyiv and western Ukraine
- 1238 King Danylo defeats Prussian crusader army
- 1240 Mongols of Ghenghis Khan sack Kyiv
- 1256 King Danylo founds Lviv, a subsequent capital of western Ukraine
- 1362 Lithuanians and Ukrainians defeat the Tatars
- 1385 Ukraine, Poland & Lithuania unite
- 1410 Ukrainian Polish, & Lithuanian armies defeat Teutonic Knights at Grunwald
- 1490 First mention of cossacks
- 1550 Hetman Vyshnyvetskyi founds the island fortress of Zaporizhia, the cossacks become an organized force
- 1569 Lublin union with Lithuania
- 1576 Ostroh Academy Kyiv, first Eastern European University
- 1648 Ukrainian War of Liberation led by Bohdan Khmelnytskyi, the Cossack state is born
- 1659 Ukrainian armies of Ivan Vyhovsky defeat the Russians in the Battle of Konotop.
- 1708 At Poltava, Ukrainian Hetman Ivan Mazepa and Karl XII of Sweden battle the Russian army led by Peter the Great
- 1710 Hetman Pylyp Orlyk institutes a democratic constitution even earlier than France or America
- 1775 Catherine the Great destroys Sich, the last stand of the democratic Cossacks
- 1814 Famous poet and artist Taras Shevchenko is born
- 1861 Abolition of serfdom
- 1918 Ukrainian National Republic is formed, on the 22nd of January
- 1932 Holodomor or artificial famine by Stalin to force collectivization, 10 million Ukrainians perish from starvation.
- 1991 Ukraine proclaims independence from the Soviet Union
- 1994 Budapest Memorandum on Security Assurances: Ukraine gives up nuclear weapons in exchange for protection of its territorial integrity by the US, England and (ironically) Russia**
- 2014 "Celestial Hundred" protesters executed in Kyiv uprising to ouster Putin's corrupt puppet, pres. Viktor Yanukovich; Russia, under Vladimir Putin, invades Crimea and eastern Ukraine — despite the Budapest Memorandum, the international response in support of Ukraine is tepid at best. Russian proxies shoot down MH17 killing 283 innocents**
- 2018 Russia's invasion of Ukraine continues, 10000 dead, 20000 injured, 2 million displaced**
- 2516 Tryzub Ukrainian Kitchen celebrates its 500th anniversary
